

EMMY AND ERIC SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Guidelines and Application Process

History:

Emmy Scott and Eric Falk were beloved members of the Christ Church family that were suddenly taken from us in 2007. They were noted for two passions in particular – their love of Service to the Lord and their love of scholarship and learning. An initial endowment for a fund remembering their contribution to our church, community and their schools of affiliation was granted in the fall of 2007.

To continue both their mission and their memory Christ Church assembled a scholarship board to oversee the growth and disbursement of these funds to a deserving individual(s).

Eligibility:

- Member or regular attendee of Christ Church Nashville
- Recipient must be a graduating high school senior through college undergraduate junior. (Rising seniors may apply).
- Must contribute to church and/or school missions projects. This must be documented by a letter from the supervising party for the mission outreach.
- Has at least one year of undergraduate college experience remaining.
- Distinguished academic achievement and demonstrated heart to serve.

Award:

The award will be determined on a yearly basis with the award amount payable directly to the college or university. This award **may be** renewed for up to three years or up to final year of college whichever comes first.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Submission of an essay describing how their education and service to the Lord has impacted their life.
- 2. Interview with a selection panel to more fully discuss their desire to receive the Emmy Scott and Eric Falk Scholarship Award.
- 3. Letter of endorsement from **both** a faculty member at your school and a leader over a mission's project. The faculty endorsement should address the scholarship ability of the student. The mission's endorsement should speak to the service ability of the student. **Written endorsements from a Christ Church Nashville employee may not be used and will not be considered.**
- 4. Statement of purpose about intended field of study, possible uses for the award and desire for receiving this award.
- 5. A recent photograph. (This will be used in print literature listing award recipients.)
- 6. Agreement to present to select groups about what the award and the memory of Emmy and Eric has impacted their life. Recipient agrees to present a minimum of three times but no more than five times.
- 7. Deadline for submission of documentation for consideration is April 15th each year. Awards are announced on Youth Graduation Sunday (date varies year-to-year).

Relevant Information:

- Monetary award will be granted by August 31st each year.
- Consideration will be given to applicants that intend or are majoring in Mathematics, English or related fields of study.
- If unclaimed by January 1 of following calendar year after award, award is forfeited.
