



# EMMY & ERIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

## HISTORY

Emmy Scott and Eric Falk were young and beloved members of the Christ Church family who went to be with the Lord in 2007. They were two friends who were noted for two passions in particular—their love of Service to the Lord and their love of scholarship and learning.

To continue both the mission and honor the memory of these two young people, an initial endowment for a fund remembering their contribution to our church, community, and their schools of affiliation was granted in the fall of 2007. Each following year, Christ Church has assembled a scholarship board to oversee the growth and disbursement of these funds to a deserving individual(s).

## ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a member or regular attendee of Christ Church Nashville
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior, undergraduate freshman, undergraduate sophomore, or undergraduate junior. (Applicant must have at least one year of undergraduate college experience remaining.)
- Applicant must have a record of contributing to church and/or school missions projects. This must be documented by a letter from the supervising party for the mission outreach.
- Applicant must demonstrate distinguished academic achievement and a devoted heart to serve others in Christian love.

## **AWARD**

The award will be determined on a yearly basis with the award amount payable directly to the college or university. This award may be renewed for up to three years or up to final year of college whichever comes first.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

1. **Personal Essay.** Applicant must submit an essay describing how their education and their faith commitment to Christ has positively impacted their own life and others.
2. **Interview.** Applications will be contacted to schedule an interview with a selection panel.
3. **Two letters of endorsement.** Letters are required from both a faculty member at your school and a leader over a mission's project. The faculty endorsement should address the scholarship ability of the student. The mission's endorsement should speak to the service ability of the student. Written endorsements from a Christ Church Nashville employee may not be used and will not be considered.
4. **Statement of purpose.** Please describe your intended field of study, possible uses for the award, and desire for receiving this award.
5. **A recent photograph.** This will be used in print literature listing award recipients.
6. **Agreement to promote the award.** Recipients may be asked to present to select groups about the intent of the award and the memory of Emmy and Eric. Recipient agrees to present a minimum of three times but no more than five times.
7. **Deadline and submission.** The deadline for submission for consideration is April 15. Preferred submission of application is emailed electronically to [linda.hilliard@ccnash.org](mailto:linda.hilliard@ccnash.org)
